Who needs to be a European Certified Hyperbaric Nurse/ Operator?

Until now, initial and continuous education and training of hyperbaric centre personnel has not been defined on a pan European level. Now EBAss (European Association of Baromedical Nurses and Operators) is pleased to launch an accreditation scheme for hyperbaric personnel. EBAss training and education programmes have been accepted by the ECHM for the training of hyperbaric personnel.

In order to be eligible for EBAss accreditation individuals must undergo training to the agreed EBAss framework. Practical assessments or examinations will be conducted by a participating facility who will be working to the approved syllabus for training as published by EBAss. Theoretical examinations will be conducted on-line via the EBAss website.

It will be a tremendous advantage for you to be certified as a European Certified Hyperbaric Nurse or Operator; this certification will show that you have received education/training accepted by EBAss and ECHM. These Education/training courses are on the same level regardless of where in Europe they are run.
